## Year 8 Camp to Victor Harbor Wednesday 30 January to Friday 1 February 2019

Dear Parents/Caregivers,

During Week 1 Term 1 each year, we invite all year 8 students to participate in a fun and exciting camp where students and teachers get the opportunity to build positive working relationships, which paves the way for a productive and successful year of learning. The camp is an important element of the students' transition into Year 8, as they come from a number of primary schools. The skills gained by students will hold them in good stead for a successful life at Oakbank Area School. Students will participate in water and team building activities requiring communication, optimism, perseverance and self-discipline, which are our school values. This program is provided by expert staff through the Victor Harbor Aquatics Program.

Students will travel by bus to the Toc-H campsite on Wednesday 30 January and return to school on Friday 1 February. They will be accompanied by middle school staff members.

Students will participate in the following activities:

Windsurfing	Snorkelling
Body Boarding	Surfing
Kayaking	Surf Safety

The total cost of the camp per student is **\$220.00 inclusive of GST**, which covers bus transport, accommodation in air conditioned dormitories, all activities provided by trained professionals and fully catered meals (except for the first day's packed lunch from home).

**Attached to this letter is an invoice for payment (arrangements for this can be made through our front office), an excursion consent form, an aquatics/swimming consent form and information about what to pack for camp. The forms and payment for the camp need to be, if possible, returned to our front office by the end of Term 4 this year or the week before school goes back next year so we can finalise numbers and alternative arrangements if needed.**

I encourage all year 8 students to take the opportunity to participate in this camp. Any students not attending the camp are required to attend school and will participate in an alternative program for the three days.

Students that are not strong swimmers are supported by the professional Aquatics team in a very safe way and the skills they will learn in the process will be invaluable for their overall water safety. ## Students SHOULD bring on camp:

### Sleeping gear

- Sleeping bag / quilt
- Pillow
- Bed sheet

### Appropriate comfortable clothing for outdoor activities

- Shorts
- T-shirts
- Trousers/Jeans
- Track pants
- Jumper
- Waterproof jacket
- Pyjamas
- Underwear and socks
- Sturdy comfortable walking shoes

- Bathers/Board shorts
