- I understand that should I be declared bankrupt, receive the benefit of law for the relief of insolvent debtors or be convicted of any offence of dishonesty, or of a sexual nature involving a minor, or of violence against a person, I will be required to relinquish my membership of Oakbank School Governing Council as I will no longer meet the membership requirements.
- In addition to a person being ineligible due to being undischarged bankrupt or being convicted of an offence, the governing council constitution also outlines circumstances when a person is ineligible for election, appointment, or nomination (clause 7.5). As such, a person is not eligible for election, appointment, or nomination to the council, if that person:

- is, at the time of election, appointment, or nomination, subject to a barring notice in accordance with section 93 of the Act, and/or,
- has an intervention order issued against them in accordance with the Intervention Orders (Prevention of Abuse) Act 2009, or a foreign intervention order as defined in that Act has been issued against the person.
